LOCATION

Burntisland is located on the south coast of Fife, with a population of approximately 6,000. Burntisland railway station serves the town and provides direct links with Kirkcaldy to the north and Edinburgh to the south. There are also regular bus services around the country. It is an attractive seaside holiday destination and commuter town to Edinburgh.

DESCRIPTION

The site is immediately adjacent to the Beacon Leisure Centre, and is currently used as a car park, located north of Lammerlaws Road. The site itself already from vehicular access and is almost entirely level. The site lies approximately 400m from Burntisland train station.

SITE AREA

We understand the site extends to 0.587 hectares (1.45 acres). The plan above shows the approximate boundaries of the site highlighted in red.

PLANNING

This site is identified as BUR 008 in the Adopted Local Development Plan – FIFEplan (Adopted September 2017), with the description of Employment. The site is allocated for Class 4 (business) – office development. Interested parties should make their own enquiries of the local planning authority, Fife Council, in relation to any proposed uses for the site. A Flood Risk Assessment requires to be undertaken prior to development on this site.

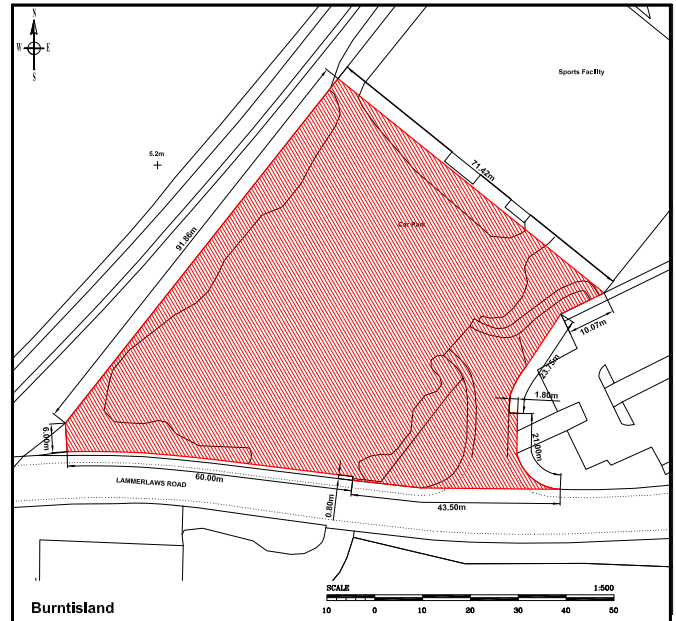
